Fee Assistance Programs

Lac La Biche County has 2 programs to reduce financial barriers to accessing sports and recreational opportunities:

1) KidSport

KidSport provides grants to children from families facing financial barriers, so they can participate in registered sport programs. KidSport Lac La Biche provides financial support up to \$500 per eligible child, per calendar year towards sport registration fees. Apply by paper form available at the Bold Centre or online at yourlocalbuzz.ca or online on the website.

2) Fair Access

All Lac La Biche County residents should have fair and equal access to County programs, services, and recreation facilities, but cost can be a barrier for some. Fair Access is a single application process for low-income residents to access County programs, services and facilities at reduced rates. Applications are accepted throughout the year, but funding is based on and must be used within each calendar year.
